Appropriation

The Municipality recently received federal funds from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration in the amount of \$603,869, which is Anchorage's allotted share of federal dollars from the Coastal Impact Assistance Program (CIAP). According to this federal program's funding formula, Anchorage was to automatically receive this amount, once the Municipality submitted its list of projects for the funding, as part of the State of Alaska's overall CIAP plan. The Assembly has previously authorized Anchorage's five CIAP projects, in AR 2001-167 on June 5, 2001, which were submitted to and approved by NOAA in the fall of 2001.

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Following are the projects that were proposed and previously approved along with funding allocations for each. The Planning Department will administer this CIAP program, which includes reporting details to NOAA. Copies of these project reports will be available for your review.
