SUBJECT: APPROVAL OF THE REVISED (SCHEMATIC) DESIGN FOR THE
PTARMIGAN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADDITION AND
RENOVATION PROJECT

In accordance with AO NO. 2000-106(S), this memorandum provides information required for submission and approval of the revised design for Ptarmigan Elementary Addition and Renovation Project. The revised design consists of a schematic design to increase Ptarmigan Elementary School from a 16-classroom to a 26-classroom elementary school. The Schematic Design was approved by the School Board on June 10, 2002.

The School Board approved the selection of Porath Tatom Architects to be the Architects of Record on January 14, 2002 and the Municipality Assembly approved the selection on January 15, 2002 (AR 2002-8). The preliminary (conceptual) design was approved by the School Board on May 13, 2002 (ASD Memorandum #288 2001-2002) and by the Municipal Assembly on May 14, 2002 (AR 2002-131).

AO NO. 2000-106(S) requires a description of the proposed school site, school building and building program; the projected student population; the total construction budget and the funding source; the projected project schedule; and any known neighborhood impacts, comments, reactions, which reflect potential impacts of the school building on the neighboring community. These responses follow:

Ptarmigan Elementary School is located on a 10-acre site in northeast Anchorage at 888 Edwards Street between DeBarr Road and the Glen Highway. The existing 16-classroom school delivers educational programs for kindergarten through sixth grade. It was built in 1971 and has had recent upgrades of the roof system in 1995 and a renovation to provide mechanical upgrades and fixed walls in 1998.

The Preliminary Plan design is based on the Districtwide Educational Specifications for a 26-Classroom Elementary School adopted by the School Board November 2000. The current student population is 432 or 138% capacity. The projected student population for the 2003/2004 school year is 444 or 141% capacity.

On April 2, 2002 voters approved \$6,400,000 to fund the design and construction of additions and renovation for Ptarmigan Elementary School. Construction is presently

1 scheduled to start in Spring 2003. The construction budget for the project is currently
2 estimated at \$4,300,000.

4 The Ptarmigan Elementary School Addition and Renovation Project scope will add eight
5 classrooms for grades one through six, two kindergarten classrooms, a multipurpose
6 room and support spaces to meet the program needs for a standard 26 classroom
7 elementary school.

9 All Building Design Committee meetings were attended by members of ASD Facilities
10 Department and members of the Ptarmigan Elementary School administration, staff,
11 teachers, and parents. All concerns brought up at these meetings have been addressed in
12 the design, and there are no anticipated negative impacts on the school building or
13 neighboring community.
