**Subject:** Appropriation of Continuation Grant under the U. S. Department of Health & Human Services Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program.

The attached resolution appropriates Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000) as a continuation grant under the MMRS Program from the United States Department of Health & Human Services to the Federal Categorical Grants Fund (241).

This grant will allow the Administration to continue ongoing planning and program implementation activities designed to prepare and equip the Municipality to respond to a large scale nuclear, biological or chemical accident, state-sponsored attack, or terrorist incident.

This federally sponsored initiative was first introduced in the fall of 1997 under the program title, "Metropolitan Medical Strike Team" (MMST). To date, the Municipality has expended approximately \$515,000 in grant funds awarded under the MMST/MMRS program to prepare a comprehensive response plan; purchase additional emergency equipment, medical supplies and pharmaceuticals; and secure needed specialized training.

The department will use this continuation grant to review and, as needed, revise current response plans, secure additional classroom training and training materials, and maintain required medical supply and pharmaceutical inventories.


