SERVICE AREA FUND (151) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND
(231) FOR THE COMMERCIAL VEHICLE ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM.


THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND EIGHT
HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$28,800), is appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska,
Department of Transportation & Public Facilities MS/CVE to the State Categorical
Grant Fund (231) for Commercial Vehicle Enforcement.

Section 2. That the sum of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1000), is
appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service Area Fund (151), 2002
Anchorage Police Department Operating Budget as a contribution to the State
Categorical Grant Fund (231)

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage
and approval.

Subject: Appropriation from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities MS/CVE of a Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Grant and local match required. (\$29,800)

The Municipality of Anchorage has entered into a "standard agreement grant" with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities MS/CVE under the Motor Carrier Safety Assistance Program. This grant will be used for commercial vehicle enforcement within the Municipality in the amount of \$28,800.

The funding provided under this program will be used for the reimbursement of commercial vehicle inspections conducted in conjunction with the commercial vehicle code enforcement. Through increased commercial vehicle enforcement the residents of Anchorage will experience safer roads and reduced traffic accident injuries.

A condition of this grant is that the Department makes a voluntary contribution to cover all indirect overhead charges from the Municipality. The total projected cost to the Department is \$1000, which has been budgeted in the 2002 Operating Budget. This grant began March 1, 2002 and will end on September 30, 2002.



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
