A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROPRIATING
EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED FORTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$8,246) FROM THE
ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE ANCHORAGE ROADS AND DRAINAGE
SERVICE AREA FUND (441) FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF EAST 64TH AVENUE,
BETWEEN BURLWOOD STREET AND PETERSBURG STREET

WHEREAS, the Anchorage School District received preliminary approval
from the Planning and Zoning Commission for the vacation of the unused Ashwood
Street right-of-way, the approval of which will allow incorporation of a currently non-
contiguous playground area into the Polar Elementary School campus; and

WHEREAS, the approval is conditioned upon the improvement of East
64th Avenue, between Burlwood Street and Petersburg Street, to local residential
standards; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage School District has requested that the Project
Management & Engineering Department act to implement the improvement of East 64th
Avenue; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That eight thousand two hundred forty-six dollars (\$8,246) from the
Anchorage School District be appropriated to the Anchorage Roads and Drainage
Service Area Fund (441).

Section 2. That the \$8,246 be used for the improvement of East 64th Avenue
between Burlwood Street and Petersburg Street.




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3 SUBJECT: Assembly Resolution Appropriating Funds from The Anchorage School
4 District for the Improvement of East 64th Avenue, between Burlwood
5 Street and Petersburg Street, Project No. 00-28 (\$8,246)
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8 The accompanying resolution appropriates \$8,246 from the Anchorage School District
9 (ASD) Fund to the Anchorage Roads and Service Area Fund (441).
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11 The resolution is necessary to allow Project Management & Engineering (PM&E) to close
12 its account for the construction of East 64th Avenue to local residential standards. The
13 project was constructed at the request of the ASD, for the purpose of satisfying a Planning
14 and Zoning Commission condition precedent to the ASD's requested vacation of the
15 unused Ashwood Street right-of-way. The approval of the vacation request will allow
16 incorporation of a currently non-contiguous playground area into the Polar Elementary
17 School campus.

19 The construction of the project was completed in October 2001, experiencing a 2%
20 overrun in total cost due to increased replacement of silty foundation soils with classified
21 non-frost-susceptible gravel. This appropriation of ASD funds, of which PM&E is already
22 in receipt, will cover the overrun.
