A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING, WHEN TENDERED, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (TSA) GRANT NUMBER DTMA1G02041 IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY EIGHT THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED AND EIGHT DOLLARS (\$458,208) THROUGH THE AGENT OF THE TSA, THE MARITIME ADMINISTRATION (MARAD). THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ACCEPTS AND APPROPRIATES THIS GRANT TO THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE CAPITAL FUND (571) FOR ENHANCED FACILITY AND OPERATIONAL SECURITY AT THE PORT OF ANCHORAGE PURSUANT TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE APPROPRIATIONS ACT FOR 2002 (PUBLIC LAW 107-117).
