HONORING THE BOREALIS BULLSEYES FOR THEIR GOLD MEDAL PERFORMANCE
IN THE SCHOLASTIC DIVISION AT THE 2002 NATIONAL JUNIOR OLYMPIC THREE-
POSITION AIR RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

WHEREAS, the 2002 National Junior Olympic Three-Position Air Rifle
Championship was held in Atlanta, Georgia, June 23rd through June 25th, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the participants in the match included 152 individuals, 11 scholastic
teams, and 23 club teams representing 37 states; and

WHEREAS, the Borealis Bullseyes, representing Alaska, scored 4,561 out of a
possible 4,800; and

WHEREAS, the Borealis Bullseyes won First Place in the Scholastic Division and
were awarded gold medals, certificates, and a plaque from the Civilian Marksmanship
Program which is on display at the Birchwood Recreation and Shooting Park.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that the following
