WHEREAS, the Municipality agrees to apply for these grant funds available through this appropriation on a project-by-project basis; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality agrees to accept the terms and conditions of this appropriation and each subsequent State grant offer; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for these water quality enhancement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality agrees to maintain said projects; and

WHEREAS, on August 6, 2002, a duly advertised public hearing was held in accordance with Section 6.10.085 of the Municipal Code.

NOW THEREFORE, the Assembly of Anchorage resolves:

Section 1. That the subject State grants in the amount of *Three Million Dollars* (\$3,000,000) granted to the Municipality are hereby accepted and appropriated.

Section 2. That the Mayor of Anchorage acknowledge the acceptance of this appropriation and that he transmit to the State an executed copy of this resolution accepting said appropriation.
