SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750) FROM THE STATE OF
ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION & PUBLIC FACILITIES, DIVISION
OF STATEWIDE HIGHWAY PLANNING SAFETY OFFICE AND ONE THOUSAND
FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,050) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE ANCHORAGE
METROPOLITAN POLICE SERVICE AREA OPERATING BUDGET, ANCHORAGE
POLICE DEPARTMENT FUND (151), TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS
FUND (231) FOR THE BICYCLE SAFETY MINI-GRANT PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750), is
appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public
Facilities, Division of Statewide Highway Planning Safety Office to the State Categorical
Grants Fund (231) for this Bicycle Safety Mini-Grant.


Section 2. That the sum of ONE THOUSAND FIFTY DOLLARS (\$1,050), is
appropriated from the Anchorage Metropolitan Police Service area 2002 Operating Budget,
Anchorage Police Department Fund (151) as a contribution to the State Categorical Grants
Fund (231).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and
approval.

Subject: Appropriation from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, Division of Statewide Planning Highway Safety Office, for a Bicycle Safety Mini-Grant. (\$1,800)

The Municipality of Anchorage has received a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, Division of Statewide Planning Highway Safety Office for a Bicycle Safety Mini-Grant. This grant will be used to promote bicycle safety awareness in the amount of \$1800.

This grant will be used to sponsor a bike rodeo with the goal of providing bicycle safety information at the start of the summer. Increased bicycle safety awareness will reduce the number of bicycle injuries by the residents of Anchorage.

A special condition of this grant is that the department provides matching funds. The total projected Municipal cost is \$1,050, which has been budgeted in the 2002 Operating Budget. This grant began April 15, 2002 and will end on August 13, 2002.




