A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE, PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT, TO ENTER INTO AN AMENDMENT TO TRANSFER OF RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT (TORA) IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-SEVEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$27,000) WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES, AND APPROPRIATING THESE FUNDS TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR SUMMER LANDSCAPING AND WINTER ICE AND SNOW REMOVAL AT SELECTED BUS STOPS WITHIN THE ANCHORAGE AREA THROUGH A YOUTH WORK ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the Public Transportation Department is authorized to enter into an amendment to the Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, for a sum not to exceed Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$27,000) for landscaping and snow and ice removal at selected bus stops within the Anchorage area through a Youth Work Enhancement Program.

Section 2. That these funds are appropriated to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231).

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: Authorizing an Amendment to Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) between the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, and the Municipality of Anchorage, Public Transportation Department, and Appropriating \$27,000 of TORA funds to the State Categorical Grants Fund (231) for Youth Summer Landscaping and Winter Snow and Ice Removal at Selected Bus Stops within the Anchorage Area.

The purpose of this memorandum is to request Assembly approval of an amendment to the
Transfer of Responsibilities Agreement (TORA) in the amount of twenty-seven thousand
dollars (\$27,000) with the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public
Facilities, as funded by the Federal Highway Administration. This TORA provides for
youth employment for landscaping and passenger access improvement activities at selected
bus stops located within the Municipality of Anchorage. The grant period is January 1, 2002
through December 31, 2002. No local matching funds are required.

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The purpose of this project is to provide meaningful work experience to Anchorage area
youth. The funding will be used for the program administration/supervision and for wages
for youths between the ages of 16 and 21. The Municipality will provide the tools, plants
and materials needed for the landscaping and snow and ice removal.

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The State of Alaska requires Assembly authorization to enter into the Agreement.
Following receipt of the Assembly authorization, the State will give a final signature on the
TORA. In anticipation of this step, appropriation of the increase in grant funds is
incorporated into the Assembly Resolution.

Processing of the supplemental appropriation into the Municipality's financial system will be held until receipt of the actual award notification from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.
