A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750) FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA, DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ALASKA HIGHWAY SAFETY OFFICE AND THREE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$325) AS A CONTRIBUTION FROM THE 2002 CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA FUND (161) TO THE STATE CATEGORICAL GRANTS FUND (231) FOR MUNICIPAL YOUTH AT RISK BIKE RODEO AND SAFETY PROGRAMS.

THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RESOLVES

Section 1. That the sum of SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$750) is appropriated as a grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Transportation, Alaska Highway Safety Office to the State Categorical Grant Fund (231) Cultural & Recreational Services Department for Youth at Risk Bike Rodeo and Pedestrian Safety Programs throughout Anchorage.

Section 2. That the sum of THREE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$325) is appropriated from the Youth at Risk 2002 Operating Budget, Cultural and Recreational Services Department Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area Fund (161) as a contribution to the Sate Categorical Grant Fund (231) Cultural & Recreational Services Department for Youth at Risk Bike Rodeo and Pedestrian Safety Programs.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval

14 Department of Transportation, Alaska Highway Safety Office of a
15 Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Mini-Grant and matching funds form the Cultural &
16 Recreational Services Department.

18 The Municipality of Anchorage has received a grant in the amount of \$750.00 from the State of
19 Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, Alaska Highway Safety Office for a
20 Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Mini-Grant for the purpose of promoting bicycle and pedestrian safety
21 awareness.

22
23 This grant will be used to sponsor a bicycle rodeo and Back to School Pedestrian Safety Fair at
24 two low-income sites within the Municipality.

25
26 The Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Program Mini Grant requires that the Municipality provide a
27 match of \$1395. The required match is available in the 2002 Operating Budget of the Cultural &
28 Recreational Service Department, Budget Unit 5603. Three hundred and twenty five dollars will
29 be appropriated to the State Categorical Grant Fund. Additionally, the Municipality will provide
30 \$1070.00 in-kind donation for staff time from the 2002 Operating Budget of the Parks &
31 Recreation Division Youth at Risk Program. This grant will begin June 14, 2002 and will end
32 August 23, 2002.
