A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING NINETY-SIX THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$96,867) FROM THE ANCHORAGE MUSEUM FOUNDATION AND FOUR THOUSAND TWENTY DOLLARS (\$4,020) FROM THE CY02 MUSEUM OPERATING BUDGET, AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND (101) FOR ADMINISTRATIVE FEES TO FUND THE CURATOR OF HISTORY FOR THE ANCHORAGE MUSEUM OF HISTORY AND ART (\$100,887).

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:


Section 1. That sums not to exceed NINETY-SIX THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN DOLLARS (\$96,867) from a grant awarded by the Anchorage Museum Foundation and FOUR THOUSAND TWENTY DOLLARS (\$4,020) as a contribution for administrative costs from the 2002 Operating Budget, Areawide General Fund (101), Cultural and Recreational Services, are appropriated to the miscellaneous operational grants fund, Cultural and Recreational Services, to fund the salary and benefits of the Curator of History for eighteen months.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.




