By October 1, 2002 the Municipality of Anchorage must submit a prioritized list of capital projects to the State of Alaska to apply for State Fiscal Year (SFY) 2004 State Capital Project Matching Grant Program grants. Under terms of the relevant State statute (AS 37.06), Anchorage is eligible to receive 70% State grant funding for municipal capital projects that have been identified as the highest priority capital needs. The Municipality is statutorily required to contribute a minimum of 30% local match from non-State sources.

Attachment A represents a prioritized list of general government capital projects proposed by the Administration for submittal to the State. The funding line, as established by the State of Alaska, for SFY 2004 is \$4,253,647. Emphasis was given to projects with a secured local match. Utilities have been excluded from the application since they are able to access other sources of capital funding (e.g., other grant programs, retained earnings, and revenue bonds).

Following the Municipality's submittal of the attached prioritized list by October 1, the State will review and process the Municipality's application for capital matching grants. Later, the State will establish funding lines for all communities based on the overall program funding proposed by the Governor. The Governor's Capital Budget will then be submitted to the Alaska Legislature for appropriation of funds. Ultimately, State capital matching grants under the 70/30 program will depend upon the total level of funding authorized by the Legislature and the project-specific appropriations, which also will be determined by the Legislature.


