A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE APPROPRIATING FOUR HUNDRED FORTY-NINE THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$449,224) TO THE STATE GRANTS FUND (231), DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM THE ALASKA COMMISSION ON AGING TO ASSIST IN THE FUNDING OF COORDINATED TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That a sum of Four Hundred Forty-nine Thousand two Hundred Twenty-four Dollars (\$449,224) is hereby appropriated from the Alaska Commission on Aging to assist in the funding of coordinated transportation services for senior citizens and for people with disabilities within the Municipality of Anchorage.

Section 2. That these funds are appropriated to the State Grants Fund (231), Department of Public Transportation.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval.

Subject: Appropriating to the State Categorical Grants fund (231) a grant of

\$449,224 from U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through the Alaska Commission on Aging for Coordinated Transportation Services

for Senior Citizens within the Municipality of Anchorage.

The purpose of this memorandum is to ask for Assembly approval for the Municipality of Anchorage to accept a grant funding senior transportation. The Municipality of Anchorage received a grant award notification from the Alaska Commission on Aging. The grant is in the amount of \$449,224 and covers the period of July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2003. This Federal Older Americans Act grant through the Alaska Commission on Aging assists in the funding of the AnchorRIDES, a coordinated transportation service for Anchorage's senior citizens and people with disabilities. The required match of \$49,914 is provided through fuel, staff time and contractual paratransit services provided as 'in-kind' support to this grant from the Operating Budget of the Public Transportation Department.
