WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has offered the Municipality of Anchorage, Department of Law, a \$50,000 grant to administer the Domestic Violence Monitoring Program; and

WHEREAS, the June 22, 2001 Municipality of Anchorage Domestic Violence Action Plan identified several goals, one of which was the ability to collect and analyze key information regarding domestic violence situations; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law is willing to continue administering the Domestic Violence Monitoring Program to meet the goals of both state and local interests provided State funding is available; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

That the grant from the State of Alaska, Department of Health and Social Services, Division of Alcoholism and Drug Abuse in the amount of \$50,000 shall be appropriated to the Municipality of Anchorage, Department of Law, state categorical fund (231) for the purpose of administering the Domestic Violence Monitoring Program.

Section 2. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly.
