A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ENDORSING DEVELOPMENT OF THE HILLSIDE DISTRICT PLAN AS A REPLACEMENT FOR THE HILLSIDE WASTEWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN, AND REQUEST FOR STATE AND/OR FEDERAL FUNDING FOR PREPARATION OF THE DISTRICT PLAN.

WHEREAS, the <u>Hillside Wastewater Management Plan</u> (HWMP) was undertaken in the early 1980's to assess the performance of on-site wastewater disposal systems in the Hillside area and investigate alternative wastewater treatment systems; and

WHEREAS, the HWMP set forth recommendations for how and where on-site wastewater treatment systems should be sited, designed, constructed and maintained, as well as established sewerage service boundaries within which public sewerage service could be provided; and

WHEREAS, the HWMP was adopted more than twenty years ago and no longer provides sufficient guidance for Hillside area development and treatment of wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Anchorage 2020—Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Plan</u> was adopted in 2001 to guide development in the Anchorage Bowl over the next twenty years and includes land use policies and specific action strategies as a means to implement the plan; and

WHEREAS, the Hillside area contains two thirds of the remaining undeveloped residential land in the Anchorage Bowl; and

WHEREAS, one of the key implementation strategies in Anchorage 2020 is the development of the <u>Hillside District Plan</u> in order to provide for the orderly growth and sufficient provision of public services to the Hillside area; and

WHEREAS, the <u>Hillside District Plan</u> is intended to address the following interrelated issues in a comprehensive district plan approach:

Water supply and wastewater disposal, Areawide drainage.

Transportation and land use,

 Wildfire hazard mitigation and public safety access, and Levels of service for public facilities and services; and

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THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. When completed and adopted, the Hillside District Plan shall replace the Hillside Wastewater Management Plan as a policy guide for the Municipality:

<u>Section 2</u>. The Municipality shall pursue state and/or federal funds for development of the Hillside District Plan.

<u>Section 3</u>. The development of the <u>Hillside District Plan</u> shall be a multi-agency project begun at the earliest possible date following receipt of appropriate funds.

<u>Section 4</u>. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Assembly.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Anchorage Assembly this ______ day of December, 2002.

ATTEST

The Planning Department, in its development of the Hillside District Plan, shall consider the provisions of the Hillside Wastewater Management Plan. Upon its completion and adoption, the Hillside District Plan shall serve as a policy guide for the Municipality.

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Subject: Hillside District Plan

Anchorage 2020—Anchorage Bowl Comprehensive Plan was adopted in 2001 to guide development in the Anchorage Bowl over the next twenty years, and includes land use policies and specific action strategies as a means to implement the plan. One of the key implementation strategies is the development of the <u>Hillside District Plan</u>.

The Hillside area contains two/thirds of the remaining undeveloped residential land in the Anchorage Bowl. Recent years have seen increasing pressure to develop more housing in the Hillside area, creating issues associated with residential density, provision of public utilities and services, environmental quality, exposure to natural hazards and poor transportation access.

For the past twenty years, the main policy document used to guide development in the Hillside has been the <u>Hillside Wastewater Management Plan</u> (HWMP). Developed and adopted as a wastewater management plan in 1982, the HWMP established sewerage service area boundaries and minimum densities for new development to be served with public sewerage. Today, the HWMP no longer provides sufficient guidance for Hillside area development and disposal of wastewater.

The <u>Hillside District Plan</u>, when completed and adopted, is intended to replace the HWMP in providing for the orderly growth and sufficient provision of public utilities and services. To do so, the Plan will address the following inter-related issues in a comprehensive district plan approach:

Water supply and wastewater disposal,

Areawide drainage,

Transportation and land use,

Wildfire hazard mitigation and public safety access, and

Levels of service for public facilities and services.

Because of the multiplicity of overlapping issues, the estimated cost of undertaking the <u>Hillside</u> <u>District Plan</u> is estimated at \$1 million. Federal and state funds are actively being sought for the development of this plan.

The Administration recommends adoption of the attached resolution endorsing the development of the Hillside <u>District Plan</u> and the use of federal/state funds for its preparation.
