A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY APPROVING A CONDITIONAL USE FOR AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES CONDITIONAL USE IN THE B-3 DISTRICT FOR A BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSE PER AMC 21.40.180 D.8, FOR THE PHO MAILEE RESTAURANT, LOCATED IN SUITE #20, MINNESOTA COMMONS SUBDIVISION, BLOCK 1A; GENERALLY LOCATED ON THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF MINNESOTA DRIVE AND WEST BENSON BOULEVARD.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

<u>Section 1</u>. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use in the B-3 District for a Restaurant per AMC 21.40.180 D.8, for the PHO Mailee Restaurant, located in Suite #20, Minnesota Commons Subdivision, Block 1A, meets the applicable provisions of AMC 21.50.020 and AMC 21.50.160.

<u>Section 2</u>. The conditional use permit for an Alcoholic Beverages Conditional Use for a Restaurant License is for 1,200 square feet for the property identified in Section 1.

<u>Section 3</u>. The conditional use permit is approved subject to the following conditions:

A Notice of Zoning Action shall be filed with the District Recorder's Office within 120 days of the Assembly's approval of a final conditional use approval for a restaurant/eating place serving beer and wine in the B-3 District.

2. All uses shall conform to the plans and narrative submitted with this conditional use application.


Alcohol sales shall constitute no more than 5% of total gross receipts and are restricted to the public seating area which is limited to seven (7) tables with 26 non-fixed seats.

4. Alcohol services are available Monday through Saturday 4:00 PM to 10:00 p.m.

Each employee will have direct contact with alcohol and be trained in accordance with the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board's Liquor Server Awareness Training Program.

6. Upon demand, the applicant shall demonstrate compliance with a liquor "Server Awareness Training Program" approved by the State of Alaska Alcoholic Beverage

Beer and wine will only be served in the public seating area of the restaurant and comprise 5% of total sales as indicated in the application. There are seven tables and 26-non fixed seating. Alcohol services are from Monday through Saturday 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. The Alcoholic Beverage Control office granted a temporary license to the petitioner on September 24, 2002. The PHO Mailee restaurant's entry door is approximately 150 feet to the entry door of the Village Charter School and approximately 240 feet to the church's entry door.
