A RESOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE REQUESTING THE STATE OF ALASKA TO SEPARATELY FUND AND PROVIDE ADDITIONAL DETAIL FOR THE PROPOSED ANCHORAGE COASTAL TRAIL SOUTHERN EXTENSION

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation released the Draft Environmental Impact Statement on the "preferred route" for a south extension of the Anchorage Coastal Trail on Nov. 13 of this year and held public hearings on Dec. 11 and 12 in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the public has through March 7, 2003, to submit written comments to the state about the proposal; and

WHEREAS, the cost of constructing the 13.3 mile-long trail is conservatively estimated by the state to be in the neighborhood of almost \$40 million, about 90% of which is proposed to come from Federal Highway funds through the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) with the balance from state funds; and

WHEREAS, the southern extension of the coastal trail is not the top priority on the AMATS approved list of trail projects, it would consume, in effect, the entire AMATS trail budget for four-to-six years; and

WHEREAS, after the state completes the trail, the Municipality is expected to be responsible for operation and maintenance, paid entirely by Anchorage property taxes; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage residents only recently were provided notice that the preferred route selected by the state would require partial – and in three instances total – acquisition or condemnation of 177 parcels of primarily residential property along the bluff; and

WHEREAS, portions of the state selected preferred route runs below the bluff along the refuge area used by large mammals, including bears, raising concern for trail users safety; and

WHEREAS, the proposed route would place the trail near the South Anchorage rifle range raising concerns for the continued operation of the range now used by many residents for teaching, practicing and competing.

NOW THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

30 Section 1. That due to the significant scale of this project, that the State commit a
 31 separate allocation of funds for this project including design and construction that is above and beyond the annual funding to AMATS.

33 Section 2 That the state provide more thorough detail about the costs of construction,
 operation and right of way acquisition, the anticipated environmental consequences including
 potential interaction between trail users and wildlife, and the state's commitment to the
 continued operation of the South Anchorage rifle range.
