AO 2003-16 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO 7 THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE 8 QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND AND NO/00 DOLLARS (\$1,700,000) 9 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF PARKS AND 10 RECREATION AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA AND THE QUESTION OF AN INCREASE IN THE 11 MUNICIPAL TAX CAP LIMITATION TO PAY ASSOCIATED 12 OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS AT AN ELEC-TION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE 13 ON APRIL 1, 2003. 14 THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS: 15 16

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Section 1. It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed ONE MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THOUSAND AND NO/00 DOLLARS (\$1,700,000) for purposes of paying the costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, equipping and constructing park improvements, including the acquisition of Waldron Lake Fields, and related capital improvements throughout the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed One Million Seven Hundred Thousand and no/00 Dollars (\$1,700,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for payment of capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and

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ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property within the Municipality shall be levied without limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due. The principal of and interest on the bonds are to be paid first from general ad valorem taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Section 3. An election is to be held on April 1, 2003, in and for the Municipality, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting, both in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area and areawide, on the question to be approved. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

#### PROPOSITION NO.

## ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$1,700,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay the costs of equipping and constructing park improvements, including the acquisition of Waldron Lake Fields, and related capital improvements and increase the municipal tax cap by an annual amount up to \$120,000 to pay for associated annual operations and maintenance costs? The proposed capital improvements would be located within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated total 2003 assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area): (i) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$.89 to retire the proposed bonds, and (ii) an annual increase in the municipal tax cap (Charter 14.03(b)(2)) of approximately \$.74 to pay for annual operation and maintenance costs related to the proposed capital improvements.

The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the bonds.

### PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Estimated annual debt service of \$145,200 assumes bonds are sold as a package @ 5.25% interest, with bond repayments corresponding to the expected life of the assets financed; 20 years.

When projects are completed and fully functioning, <u>increased</u> annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$120,000.

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#### **PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

Estimated annual debt service payments of approximately \$145,200 equate to an estimated property tax increase of .0089 mills or \$.89 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks & Recreation Service Area for Waldron Lake Fields.

When fully operational, <u>increased</u> annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$120,000 and equate to an estimated property tax increase of .0074 mills or \$.74 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks & Recreation Service Area for Waldron Lake Fields.

The total private sector economic effect would therefore be the increase in the Municipal tax cap limitation related to the payment of debt service and operations and maintenance costs as shown above for a total of \$1.63 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks & Recreation Service Area for Waldron Lake Fields.
