The bond proceeds would pay costs of acquiring property for, constructing, and remodeling various areawide libraries, and related capital improvements within Anchorage and the increase in the municipal tax cap would pay the associated annual operations and maintenance costs.

Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated total 2003 areawide assessed valuation in Anchorage) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$3.31 to retire the proposed debt and (ii) an annual increase in the municipal tax cap (Charter 14.03(b)(2)) of approximately \$1.09 to pay for annual operation and maintenance costs related to the proposed capital improvements.

The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes levied and collected areawide within Anchorage. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the bonds.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

Estimated annual debt service of \$621,000 assumes bonds are sold as a package @ 5.25% interest, with bond repayments corresponding to the expected life of the assets financed; 20 years.

When projects are completed and fully functioning, <u>increased</u> annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$203,700.

SUMMARY OF ECONOMIC EFFECTS

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PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

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Estimated annual debt service payments of approximately \$621,000 equate to an estimated property tax increase of .0331 mills or \$3.31 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation Areawide (Library).

When fully operational, <u>increased</u> annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$203,700 and equate to an estimated property tax increase of .0109 mills or \$1.09 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation Areawide (Library).

The total private sector economic effect would therefore be the increase in the Municipal tax cap limitation related to the payment of debt service and operations and maintenance costs as shown above for a total of \$3.31 per \$100,000 of assessed valuation Areawide (Library).

The attached ordinance, on approval, will place a \$7,270,000 Areawide general obligation bond proposition for Library capital improvements on the ballot for the regular Municipal election to be held on April 1, 2003. The ordinance represents general obligation bond funding reflected in the Approved 2003 General Government Capital Improvement Budget (CIB), with the exception of rounding down to the nearest \$5,000 increment.
