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Section 2. That Section 27.30.370 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.30.370 Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area.

- Α. There is established, pursuant to section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service area within the municipality to be the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area of the municipality, as outlined on the map located in section 27.30.700.
- B The Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the maintenance of roads and snow plowing, commencing on January 1, 1989, and shall end on December 31, 2006 [2003], unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the area affected at the regular election of April 2006 [2003]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.50 mills in any calendar year.

Section 3. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
