AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE BEAR VALLEY LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 1, 2003 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.290 AND 27.30.370.

WHEREAS the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 88-99; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31 2003 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 1, 2003:

Shall the existence of the Bear Valley Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 2003 until December 31, 2006?

4 Section 2. That Section 27.30.370 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read
5 as follows:

7 27.30.370 Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area.

- 9 A. There is established, pursuant to section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service
10 area within the municipality to be the Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area of the
11 municipality, as outlined on the map located in section 27.30.700.
12
13 B. The Bear Valley Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the
14 maintenance of roads and snow plowing, commencing on January 1, 1989, and
15 shall end on December 31, 2006 [2003], unless the service area is extended by an
16 affirmative vote of the area affected at the regular election of April 2006 [2003]. The
17 mill rate shall not exceed 1.50 mills in any calendar year.
18

19 Section 3. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.
20 Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the
21 regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is
22 approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.

11 SUBJECT: Extension of Limited Road Service Areas

14 The Bear Valley, Section 6/Campbell Airstrip Road, Sequoia Estates, Talus West,
15 Upper O'Malley and Villages Scenic Parkway Limited Road Service Areas expire on
16 December 31, 2003, unless continued by an affirmative vote in the service areas
17 affected. Therefore, six ordinances have been presented requesting the Assembly
18 propose ballot questions to extend the life of these Limited Road Service Areas.

20 There will be no additional economic impact on the private or public sector.

22 Approval of the ordinances will place the propositions on the ballot for a vote at the
23 April 1, 2003 Regular Election.
