AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING IN THE TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION APRIL 1, 2003 A BALLOT PROPOSITION APPROVING THE CONTINUATION OF SAID LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA FOR AN ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF THREE YEARS. ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTIONS 27.20.120 AND 27.30.200.

WHEREAS the Talus West Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance 79-234; and

WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31 2003 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the qualified voters residing in the Talus West Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal election on April 1, 2003:

CONTINUATION OF THE  
TALUS WEST LIMITED ROAD SERVICE AREA

Shall the existence of the Talus West Limited Road Service area be continued for an additional period of three (3) years after December 31, 2003 until December 31, 2006?

4 Section 2. That Section 27.30.200 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read  
5 as follows:

7 **27.30.200 Talus West Limited Road Service Area.**  
8


9 There is an established limited road service area within the municipality known as  
10 the Talus West Limited road Service Area (TWLRSA) as depicted on the map  
11 located in section 27.30.700. The Talus West Limited Road Service Area shall  
12 provide limited road maintenance within the service area commencing on January  
13 1, 1980, and ceasing December 31, 2006 [2003], unless extended by an affirmative  
14 vote in the area affected at the regular election of April 2006 [2003]. The mill rate  
15 shall not exceed 1.3 mill in any calendar year.  
16

17 Section 3. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.  
18 Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the  
19 regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is  
20 approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
