19 WHEREAS the Upper O'Malley Limited Road Service Area was created by Anchorage Ordinance
20 79-234; and

22 WHEREAS a showing of interest in continuing said limited road service beyond December 31
23 2003 has been made by persons residing in said limited road service area; now therefore,

27 Section 1. That a ballot proposition in substantially the following form shall be submitted to the
28 qualified voters residing in the Upper O'Malley Limited Road Service Area at the regular Municipal

4 | Section 2. That Section 27.30.210 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read
5 | as follows:

7 | 27.30.210 Upper O'Malley Limited Road Service Area.
8


9 | There is established a limited road service area within the municipality to be known
10 | as the Upper O'Malley Limited Road Service Area (UOLRSA) as depicted on the
11 | map located in section 27.30.700. The Upper O'Malley Limited Road Service Area
12 | shall provide limited road maintenance to the area within the service area
13 | commencing on January 1, 1980, and ceasing December 31, 2006 [2003], unless
14 | extended by an affirmative vote in the area affected at the regular election of April
15 | 2006 [2003]. The mill rate for the service area shall not exceed 2.0 mills in any
16 | calendar year.
17

18 | Section 3. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.
19 | Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the
20 | regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is
21 | approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
