page 2 - Villages Scenic Parkway LRSA

Section 2. That Section 27.30.390 of the Anchorage Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

27.30.390 Villages Scenic Parkway Limited Road Service Area.

- A. There is established, pursuant to section 9.01 of the Charter, a limited road service area within the municipality to be the Villages Scenic Parkway Limited Road Service Area of the municipality, as outlined on the map located in section 27.30.700.
- **B.** The Villages Scenic Parkway Limited Road Service Area shall contribute funds expressly for the maintenance of roads, snow plowing and sanding commencing January 1, 1989, and shall end on December 31, <u>2006</u> [2003], unless the service area is extended by an affirmative vote of the area affected at the regular election of April <u>2006</u> [2003]. The mill rate shall not exceed 1.00 mill in any calendar year.

<u>Section 3</u>. Except for Section 2, this ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval. Section 2 and the proposition contained in Section 1 shall become effective upon certification of the regular election on the proposition called for by this ordinance, but only if that proposition is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition.
