## ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2003-33

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY AT THE APRIL, 2003 REGULAR MUNICIPAL ELECTION A BALLOT PROPOSITION TO AMEND THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CHARTER BY ADDING TO THE CHARTER'S BILL OF RIGHTS A NEW SECTION TO ESTABLISH THE CITIZENS' RIGHT TO OBJECTIVE PERFORMANCE MEASURES BY WHICH CITIZENS MAY BE ASSURED THAT THE NATURAL URBAN SETTING, WILDLIFE, BEAUTY AND HORTICULTURAL HERITAGE OF THE MUNICIPALITY IS PROMOTED.

## THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. A proposition in substantially the following form and substance shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the Municipality at the regular Municipal election April 1, 2003:

## PROPOSITION No. \_\_\_\_\_ RIGHT TO OBJECTIVE PERFORMANCE STANDARDS BY WHICH THE MUNICIPALITY'S NATURAL BEAUTY, URBAN SETTING AND HORTICULTURAL HERITAGE IS PROMOTED.

Shall Article II of the Municipality of Anchorage Charter be amended to add the following section 15. to the Charter's Article II, Bill of Rights?

(New language is underlined.)

This Charter guarantees rights to the people of Anchorage that are in addition to rights guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States of America and the Constitution of the State of Alaska. Among rights guaranteed by this Charter are:

(14) The right to standards by which the citizens of Anchorage may be assured that its natural urban setting in a wilderness area, its connection to wildlife, and it's natural horticultural beauty are promoted through the use of objective performance measures.

Section 2. Sections 1. and 2. of this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Assembly. The proposition contained in Section 1. of this ordinance shall become effective upon certification of the April 1, 2003 general election, if and only if, the
