AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AT ITS NEXT REGULAR ELECTION ON APRIL 1, 2003, A BALLOT PROPOSITION ON THE QUESTION OF WHETHER TO AMEND ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CHARTER ARTICLE 11, ELECTIONS, ADDING A NEW CLAUSE REGARDING VOTING RIGHTS OF MINORS.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. That a proposition in substantially the same form as appears in Section 2 below, shall be placed on the ballot at the next regular election. The vote on the proposition shall be limited to the qualified voters residing in the Municipality of Anchorage. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting on the question to be approved.

<u>Section 2</u>. That proposition shall be presented in substantially the following form:

A CHARTER AMENDMENT TO PERMIT 16 AND 17 YEAR OLD RESIDENTS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE WHO MEET ALL VOTER QUALIFICATIONS EXCEPT AGE 18 TO VOTE IN ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS.
