AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE AT ITS NEXT REGULAR ELECTION ON APRIL 1, 2003 AN ADVISORY PROPOSITION ON THE QUESTION OF CHANGING THE MINIMUM VOTING AGE FOR STATE AND LOCAL ELECTIONS FROM 18 TO 16 YEARS OF AGE.

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:
