### ORDINANCE NO. AO 2003-40

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY PROVIDING FOR THE SUBMISSION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF ANCHORAGE, ALASKA, THE QUESTION OF THE ISSUANCE OF FIVE MILLION TWO-HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,225,000) OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE TO PAY THE COSTS OF PARKS AND RECREATION AND RELATED CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA AND THE QUESTION OF AN INCREASE IN THE MUNICIPAL TAX CAP LIMITATION TO PAY ASSOCIATED OPERATIONS AND MAINTENANCE COSTS AT AN ELECTION IN AND FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE ON APRIL 1, 2003.

### THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY HEREBY ORDAINS

Section 1 It is hereby determined to be for a public purpose and in the public interest of the Municipality of Anchorage, Alaska (the "Municipality") to incur general FOUR MILLION NINE obligation bonded indebtedness in an amount not to exceed FIVE-MILLION-TWO HUNDRED NINETY FIVE (\$4,995,000) HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$5,225,000) for purposes of paying the costs of planning, designing, acquiring property for, equipping and constructing park improvements, recreational facilities, trail upgrades, and related capital improvements throughout the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area

Section 2. The sum of not to exceed Five Million Two Hundred Twenty-Five (\$4,995,000)
Thousand Dollars (\$5;225,000) shall be borrowed by, for and on behalf of the Municipality for the aforesaid capital improvements and shall be evidenced by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the Municipality. The bond proceeds shall be used only for payment of capital improvements and costs of issuance of the bonds. The full faith and credit of the Municipality is pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on the bonds, and ad valorem taxes upon all taxable property within the Municipality shall be levied without

limitation as to rate or amount to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds when due.

The principal of and interest on the bonds are to be paid first from general ad valorem taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Section 3. An election is to be held on April 1, 2003, in and for the Municipality, for the purpose of submitting a general obligation bond proposition to the qualified voters of the Municipality for approval or rejection. The proposition must receive a majority vote of those in the Municipality voting, both in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area and areawide, on the question to be approved. The proposition shall be substantially in the following form:

### PROPOSITION NO

# ANCHORAGE PARKS AND RECREATION SERVICE AREA CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BONDS

\$4,995,000

Shall Anchorage borrow up to \$5,225,000 through the issuance of general obligation bonds to pay the costs of equipping and constructing park improvements, recreational facilities, trail upgrades and related capital improvements and increase the municipal tax cap by an annual amount up to \$132,000 to pay for associated annual operations and maintenance costs? The proposed capital improvements would be located within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

Voter approval of this bond proposition authorizes for each \$100,000 of assessed taxable property value (based on the estimated total 2003 assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area): (i) an annual increase in taxes of approximately \$2.87 to retire the proposed bonds, and (ii) an annual increase in the municipal tax cap (Charter 14.03/b)(2)) of approximately \$2.81 to pay for appual operation

\$ .63 14.03(b)(2)) of approximately \$.81 to pay for annual operation and maintenance costs related to the proposed capital improvements.

The debt shall be paid from real and personal property taxes levied and collected within the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area. Anchorage will also pledge its full faith and credit for payment of the bonds.

Section 4. The proposition, both for paper ballots and machine ballots, shall

be printed on a ballot which may set forth other general obligation bond propositions, and the following words shall be added as appropriate and next to a square provided for marking the ballot or voting by a machine: PROPOSITION NO. Yes No Section 5. Section 2 of this Ordinance shall become effective only if the proposition described in Section 3 is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting on the proposition at the general election on April 1, 2003. #### **PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

The estimated annual debt service of \$467,404 assumes bonds are sold as a package @ 5.25% interest.

When projects are completed, annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$132,000.

#### **PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:**

The estimated annual debt service of approximately \$467,404 equate to an estimated property tax increase of .0287 mills or \$2.87 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation in the Anchorage Parks and Recreation Service Area.

In addition, annual operations and maintenance costs are estimated at \$132,000 and equate to an estimated property tax increase of \$0.81 per year on \$100,000 of assessed valuation.

**IMPROVEMENTS** 

AO 2003-40 is being submitted to increase the Parks and Recreation Bond Ordinance by \$330,000 of which \$300,000 would be used to upgrade Campbell Airstrip Road between mile 1.1 and 2.7 located within a Municipal park, and \$30,000 to cover the annual operation and maintenance costs.

If approved, the total costs to the taxpayer for this bond package would be an annual increase in taxes of \$2.87 per \$100,000 of the assessed valuation to retire the proposed bonds, and an annual increase in the Municipal tax cap of approximately \$0.81 to pay for annual operation and maintenance costs.

Your approval of AO 2003-40 is recommended.
