3 SUBJECT: Ordinances Amending Municipal Code 3.30.157 <u>Injury Leave</u>

Anchorage Municipal Code Section 3.30.157 Injury Leave establishes benefits for employees on leave due to a work related injury. Employee Relations is seeking to amend this section to incorporate changes that parallel changes made in the Injury Leave article in the Teamsters, Public Service Employees and Operating Engineers bargaining agreements recently approved by Assembly action.

11 The Injury Leave code change requires employees to draw down leave for the first three day period of 12 an occupational injury. If the injury absence exceeds 28 days, the employee is made whole for the first 13 three day period. This code change also provides employees released to light duty following an 14 occupational injury not to have to use leave to attend doctor's appointments that could not be scheduled 15 during non-work hours.
