Plat Number 98-80: Lots 1 and 2 Block 5, Lots 1 Through 12 Block 6, Lots 1 Through 6 Block 7, and Tracts 4A, 4B and 4C Powder Ridge Subdivision Phase 2. Plat Number 2002-77: Tracts A. B. and C Polaris North Subdivision, Plat Number 2001-123; Tracts 1C and 1D Northgate Business Park, Plat Number 2002-45; Tracts 2A. 3A and 4 Northgate Business Park. Plat Number 84-503; and that Portion of the Southwest Ouarter of Section 36, T15N R2W Seward Meridian that lies North of the North Eagle River Access Road, West of the Old Glenn Highway, and East of the Glenn Highway, should be de-annexed from the Chugiak Fire Service Area and annexed to the Anchorage Fire Service Area; and

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WHEREAS, the Assembly finds that it is in the best interests of the public to submit this question to the qualified voters of each area; and


Section 3. Anchorage Municipal Code section 27.30.050 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Service Area De-Annexation.

Residents of the Powder Ridge area are interested in having their subdivision annexed to the Anchorage Fire Service Area and detached from the Chugiak Fire Service Area. The attached ordinance sets forth ballot propositions that, if passed, would accomplish this request, and also provides two options for the election. The first option provides for a special election if a runoff election takes place May 6, 2003. If not, the questions will be presented to the municipal voters in the next regular election of April 2004. In accordance with the attached map A-1, this ordinance AO 2003-50 encompasses a larger area than AO-2003-49. The larger area encompassed by AO 2003-50 includes the Powder Ridge area as well as Polar North Subdivision, Northgate Business Park, and portions of the SW Corner of Section 36. This area is depicted on Exhibit A-1, the map attached to the ordinance, as well as in the legal description contained in the text of the ordinance.

PUBLIC SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The 2002 assessed value within the Chugiak Fire SA was \$521,628,266 with a mill levy of 0.99 mills representing \$516,412 in total taxes. AO 2003-50 would annex an area with an assessed value of \$11,737,400 into the Anchorage Fire SA leaving the Chugiak Fire SA with an assessed value of \$509,890,866. The new amount of Fire SA taxes eligible for collection would be \$504,792, a revenue reduction of \$11,620 to the Chugiak Fire SA.

The Powder Ridge residents voting to annex into the Anchorage Fire SA would now incur the current mill levy of 1.69 mills and an increase in Fire SA tax from \$14,390 to \$19,836.

PRIVATE SECTOR ECONOMIC EFFECTS:

The average assessed value for the property owners in this area is \$231,248 (using 2002 numbers). Based on the 2003 preliminary mill rate of 1.69 mills, the estimated average tax due for fire service would be \$391. If the property owners remained in the Chugiak Fire SA, the estimated tax due for fire service would be \$229. This represents an increase in annual taxes of \$162 to annex into the Anchorage Fire SA.

Note: All calculations address only the Fire SA levy portion of the annual tax bill.
