23SUBJECT:4AO 2003-51, AN ORDINANCE ADDING AN EXCEPTION TO AMC516.90.010 TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF TOBACCO PRODUCTS5IN MUNICIPAL STRUCTURES OWNED BY THE ANCHORAGE6PARKING AUTHORITY

AO 2003-51 would allow tobacco sales in facilities operated by the Anchorage Parking
Authority. This ordinance has apparently been introduced at the request of the owners of
the Bus Stop Grocery located in the 6th Avenue Mall. In light of the introduction, a brief
history of the lease to the Bus Stop Grocery and the banning of tobacco sales in the 6th
Avenue Mall are appropriate.

The initial lease for Bus Stop Grocery was entered into in February 1992 with Mr. and
Mrs. Brooks. This was a 10-year lease that allowed the sale of "traditional convenience
grocery store items."

In December of 1994, the Brooks' assigned the remainder of the lease to Mr. Inn Soo Hann. The Anchorage Parking Board of Directors approved this assignment as required in the lease. As part of the Assignment, the landlord and new tenant agreed to amend the lease to include a provision allowing a 4-year extension of the lease to be negotiated in good faith at the end of the initial term. The agreement specifically allowed the Landlord to change the terms of the lease and allowed that the tenant could accept or reject the offered extension.

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In February 1998, the Municipal Attorneys office informed Anchorage Parking that AMC 27 16.90.010 prohibited the sale of tobacco products in the 6th Avenue Mall. In February 28 1998, Mr. Han requested assignment of the remainder of the lease to Mr. Yang Kim and 29 Ms. Sonny Lee. During review of the assignment and before approval by the Anchorage 30 Parking Board of Directors, Anchorage Parking informed both parties that the "traditional 31 convenience grocery store items." language would be honored for the original term of the 32 lease (through January 2002). They were also informed at that time that any 33 negotiated extension would prohibit the sale of tobacco products. 34

In December 2001, Anchorage Parking began negotiating with Ms. Lee regarding an extension of the Bus Stop Grocery lease. Ms. Lee challenged the decision that AMC 16.90.010 applied to the 6th Avenue Mall. At that point, Anchorage Parking requested a written legal opinion from the Municipal Attorney on this issue. The opinion was received in April of 2002 and confirmed that AMC 16.90.010 applied to the 6th Avenue Mall. At that point, the Anchorage Parking Board of Directors made a final determination that tobacco products would no longer be sold in the 6th Avenue Mall. The Board of Directors was also concerned that tobacco products not be sold in a public facility frequented by so many voung people. In exchange for the prohibition of tobacco sales, Anchorage Parking provided a significant reduction in the monthly lease rate for the Bus Stop Grocery of approximately \$500.00 per month. The current request to exempt the 6th Avenue Mall from restrictions applied to other public facilities is neither requested nor supported by Anchorage Parking. In this instance, there appears no logical justification for treating this Municipal facility differently from other Municipal facilities. Prepared by: Kevin J.
