AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING
ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 17.10.090, OFF-LEASH DOG PARK SPACES,
TO UNDESIGNATE THE OLD ALASKA NATIVE HOSPITAL SITE AS AN OFF-LEASH DOG
PARK SPACE

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1: That Anchorage Municipal Code Section 17.10.090, Off-leash Dog Park
Spaces, is amended to read as follows:

17.10.090 Off-Leash dog park spaces.

- A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, legally licensed dogs with current
rabies vaccinations may be allowed, unleashed, in areas recommended by the Animal
Control Advisory Board with concurrence of the Parks and Recreation Commission and
the Mayor, subject to approval by the Assembly. Such areas shall include, but are not
limited to, designated areas within the following locations:

University Lake Park
Far North Bicentennial Park (North Gasoline Trail)
Russian Jack Park
Connors Bog
South Anchorage Sports Park (Future American Legion Trails)

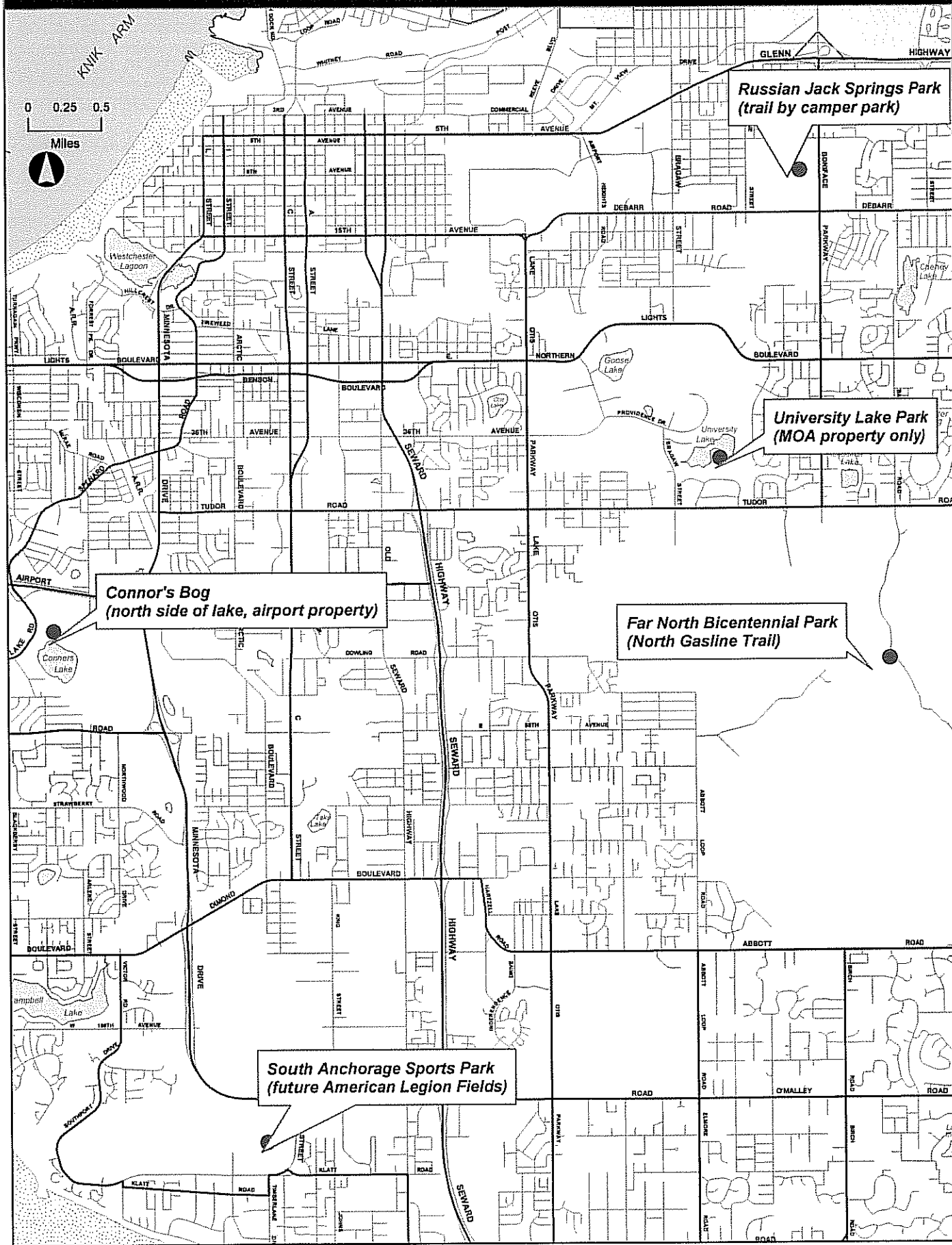
