

ANCHORAGE, ALASKA AO NO. 2003-151

AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 21.10.030, BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT, TO MAKE A CORRECTIVE AMENDMENT TO DELETE THE PHRASE "TO SERVE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE THREE SITTING MEMBERS."

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY ORDAINS:

Section 1. Anchorage Municipal Code subsection 21.10.030B.1 is amended to read as follows: (Other subsections are not affected and therefore not set out.)

21.10.030 Board of adjustment.

- B. The board of adjustment shall be:
 - 1. A three-member board of adjustment, with two alternate members [TO SERVE IN THE ABSENCE OF THE THREE SITTING MEMBERS], for appeals from the platting board and the planning and zoning commission, whose members are nominated by the mayor and confirmed by eight members of the assembly for three-year staggered terms. The board's seats shall be designated Seats 1, 2, and 3. The board members shall be knowledgeable and experienced in administrative law and in the provisions of Title 21 of the Municipal Code.
 - 2. The planning and zoning commission, for appeals from the hearing officer.

Section 3. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage and approval.
