A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF LEGISLATION TO EXTEND TREATMENT FOR UNINSURED WOMEN DIAGNOSED WITH BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER

WHEREAS, in 2001 the State Legislature expanded Medicaid coverage for treatment of uninsured women who were diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer under the Federally funded Center for Disease Control's (CDC) Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program; and

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the most diagnosed cancer in Alaska, with statistics revealing that one in seven Alaska women will develop this type of cancer in their lifetime resulting in worry and uncertainty for those who cannot afford treatment; and

WHEREAS, the CDC Program provides grants for screening exams to millions of people who meet the eligibility guidelines within the United States and Alaska resulting in breast exams, pelvic exams, and mammograms; and

WHEREAS, prior to the 2001 Breast and Cervical Center Prevention and Treatment Act, Federal funds did not provide for follow-up treatment to uninsured persons diagnosed with cancer; and

WHEREAS, due to the two-year sunset clause attached to the current bill, this Program will no longer be available effective June 26, 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Assembly resolves:

<u>Section 1</u>: That this body supports and recommends passage of legislation to extend treatment for uninsured women who have been diagnosed with breast or cervical cancer through the Center for Disease Control's Breast and Cervical Cancer Early Detection Program.

Section 2: That the Municipal Administration and the Assembly commit to vigorously encourage passage of legislation during the 23<sup>rd</sup> Legislature's 1<sup>st</sup> Session January 21<sup>st</sup> - May 21, 2003.

<u>Section 3</u>: That copies of this resolution are forwarded to the Alaska State Legislature and the Governor.
