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23 24 All Building Design Committee meetings were attended by members of ASD Facilities Department and members of the Polaris K-12 School administration, staff, teachers, and parents. The Abbott Loop Community Council requested an improved sidewalk on the north side of 64<sup>th</sup> Street as part of the school s project. However, since this work appears to be outside of the scope of the addition and renovations project, this item has not been included in the design. Other than this issue, all concerns brought up at these meetings have been addressed in the design, and there are no anticipated negative impacts on the school building or neighboring community.

Phased construction is anticipated to begin in June 2004, with a tentative construction project completion schedule of August 2006 for all phases. This schedule is contingent on passage of an \$18.6 million bond proposition (April, 2003) for the construction phase of this project. The Schematic Design Construction Cost Estimate exceeded the established construction budget; however, the District has identified cost reductions that bring the total project within the available funding.

The Schematic Design site, floor plan, and perspective drawing are included as attachment A.
