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The Municipality of Anchorage currently has several resources that offer youth in crisis a safe and secure place off the streets. To complement these efforts, establishment of a Juvenile Assessment Center would provide offending youth a safe temporary location, and our law enforcement officers would have a "known" facility to place youth while the parent or responsible party is being located.

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The requested appropriation would provide a local match to contributions from other public and nonprofit entities who feel strongly that Anchorage is in dire need of this project. It is envisioned that the United Way would be the recipient of the grant monies and, through this agency, all of the funding would be disbursed for the purpose of a preliminary investigation, planning, and organization of a Juvenile Assessment Center.
