2 COMMUNITY CHALLENGE GRANT FROM AMERICA'S PROMISE TO
3 MISCELLANEOUS OPERATIONAL GRANTS FUND (261) IN THE AMOUNT OF
4 TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000) AND FROM THE AREA WIDE
5 GENERAL FUND (101) IN THE AMOUNT OF EIGHT HUNDRED THIRTY DOLLARS
6 (\$830) AS A VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION FROM THE CULTURAL &
7 RECREATIONAL SERVICES 2003 OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE PURPOSE OF
8 CREATING AND PROMOTING ANCHORAGE'S PROMISE CHECKLIST WHICH
9 INCLUDES STRENGTHENING OUR COMMUNITY OF PROMISE, AND
10 ORGANIZING, PLANNING, AND EXECUTING COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER
11 PROJECTS IN CONJUNCTION WITH AMERICA'S PROMISE AND YOUTH SERVICE
12 AMERICA'S NATIONAL YOUTH SERVICE DAY 2003.

14 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage is an All America City partly due to the civic
15 involvement of our youth and youth programs such as Youth Court and Special Olympics; and
16

17 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage recognizes the important role our youth
18 play in the future health and growth of our community; and

20 WHEREAS, Cultural & Recreational Services (CRS) staffs and provides guidance to
21 the Youth Advisory Commission, presents youth programs in all divisions, and organizes
22 youth volunteers for various community events; and,

24 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage is already a Community of Promise and
25 has committed to its youth through the Five Promises; and,
26

27 WHEREAS, the Anchorage Assembly proclaimed Tuesday, August 20, 2002 as
28 Anchorage's Promise and America's Promise Day, further establishing the Assembly's
29 commitment to providing the Five Promises to children and youth in Anchorage; and,

31 WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage, Cultural & Recreational Services has
32 applied for and been named a Youth Service America Lead Agency for National Youth
33 Service Day (NYSD) 2003 which is a nationwide effort to stage youth service-learning projects
34 to benefit communities and teach youths valuable job skills; and,

36 WHEREAS, as a Lead Agency, CRS will work with a contract employee funded by this
37 grant to convene a city, regional, or state-wide coalition of organizations that are interested in
38 planning and implementing service projects for youth volunteers on NYSD 2003 and beyond;

41 WHEREAS, as a Lead Agency, CRS will also coordinate media outreach, engage
42 elected officials and other VIPs, plan an opening rally and/or closing celebration, and serve as
43 liaison to Youth Service America; and

45 WHEREAS, past National Youth Service Day events in Anchorage have been
46 successful and benefited the youth specifically and the community in general; now therefore

THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY RESOLVES:

Section 1. That the sum of twenty five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from America's Promise is appropriated to Miscellaneous Operational Grants Fund (261) and shall be administered by the CRS department for the purposes of employing a staff contractor. The staff contractor will develop the Promise Checklist for the Anchorage Community and plan, organize, report, and stage in April 2003 a National Youth Service Day in conjunction with the Anchorage Coalition for Positive Youth Development.


Section 2. The sum of Eight Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$830) is appropriated as a voluntary contribution from the Cultural & Recreational Services 2003 operating budget, Area Wide General Fund (101), to further fund costs associated with the staff contractor.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Anchorage Municipal Assembly.

SUBJECT: A Resolution Appropriating a Twenty-Five Thousand Dollar (\$25,000) pass through Dell Foundation Community Challenge Grant from America's Promise and Eight Hundred Thirty Dollars (\$830) as a voluntary contribution from the Cultural & Recreational Services 2003 operating budget to create and promote Anchorage's Promise checklist.

By accepting this grant from America's Promise, Cultural & Recreational Service's (CRS) commitment would be to provide an office for at least one year with CRS office machines and furniture. Office space currently exists within the confines of the Administration Division and can accommodate another person without disrupting its regular work.

CRS will be fiscally responsible for grant money and provide matching in kind contributions in the way of office space, telephone, fax, computer with Internet access, administrative services for mailing and copying, liability insurance and day parking. Separate account tracking will be in place to track revenues and expenditures related to this grant. CRS will have the office ready for start up in February.

America's Promise and Youth Service America are joining resources and efforts to present the 15th annual National Youth Service Day (NYSD) in April, 2003. Last year, with the support of Scholastic Inc. and State Farm Insurance, more than 10,000 children's books were sorted and distributed for low-income children and their families. Anchorage youth and Prudential Youth Leadership Institute graduates organized literacy mentoring activities and conducted a community wide youth service recognition dinner for 300 youths and adults at Wendler Middle School.

MOA agrees to create and promote Anchorage's Promise checklist. MOA will use the grant funds to pay an Anchorage's Promise contract staff salary. Other grants and fund raising efforts will cover costs of the NYSD 2003.
