Appropriating the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Grant, in Support of Transportation Planning in Anchorage, by way of the

Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS)

Program, for the calendar year 2003

The Federal Highway Administration, through the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, makes funding available on an annual basis to the Municipality to supplement existing State and local financial support for the Anchorage Metropolitan Area Transportation Solutions (AMATS) planning process. Based on a State allocation formula, six hundred twenty-seven thousand, six hundred fifty-two dollars [\$627,652] will be made available from Alaska's federal Planning (PL) funds. These PL monies may be used to fund expenses incurred in relation to the AMATS planning process. They may not be used for any other purpose. If not utilized by the Municipality, these funds will be redistributed to other urban areas in the State.

This funding will be utilized during the upcoming calendar year to enable staff to perform local and regional transportation plans and programs. PL funds are not used for project design and construction; they will be used to continue support of existing

staff positions.

The Federal Highway Administration stipulates federal dollars may provide not more than ninety and ninety-seven hundredths percent (90.97%) of the total basic program. Local funding must support at least nine and three hundredths percent (9.03%) of the program. The required local match is sixty-two thousand three hundred and three dollars [\$62,303]. The Office of Planning, Development, and Public Works/Traffic Department, will supply the required local match through provision of in-kind services. These funds were already allocated within the Department's operating budget, and do not require additional appropriation.
