A Resolution Approving the Memorandum of Understanding By and Between

Vision Anchorage and the Municipality

Vision Anchorage is a steering committee of 40 representatives from the public and private sectors, formed to create an economic development plan for the Anchorage area. This plan will serve as a blueprint for future economic revitalization, job creation and new business development.

In August of 2001, the Mayor, along with the chairmen of the Anchorage Economic Development Corporation and the Anchorage Chamber of Commerce, invited Anchorage business and committee leaders to serve on the team which eventually became Vision Anchorage. The Municipality, with Assembly concurrence, funded a major portion (\$150,000) of the consultant's study that Vision Anchorage ultimately produced.

The consultants, Chabin Concepts, issued a report entitled, "Call to Action, Creating and Sustaining Economic Vitality in Anchorage," in November of 2002. Contained within the report are five strategic initiatives designed to prepare Anchorage for economic growth in the future. They are:

 Collaborative leadership initiative Readiness initiative (ready to build sites)

Work force development initiative

Education initiative

Business development initiative

The Administration supports the efforts of Vision Anchorage to implement the five strategic initiatives identified. The attached resolution is intended to demonstrate the full support of the Municipality of Anchorage in participating in and helping achieve these measures.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding is entered into by and between VISION ANCHORAGE, an ad hoc steering committee of community business leaders, which has formulated an Anchorage economic development plan known as a "Call to Action," the Municipality of Anchorage ("Municipality"), and other signatories hereto.

WHEREAS, Vision Anchorage commissioned a series of studies leading to the development of an Anchorage economic development plan; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality worked with Vision Anchorage and its consultants in the preparation of the economic development plan; and

WHEREAS, the culmination of the process was a "Call to Action," an economic development plan for creating and sustaining economic vitality in Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, the Call to Action has identified five strategic initiatives which are critical for Anchorage's future success as follows:

- Collaborative leadership initiative
- Readiness initiative (ready to build sites)
 Work force development initiative
- Education initiative
- Business development initiative

WHEREAS, each initiative referred to above relies upon the endorsement and support from not only the Anchorage community as a whole, but, as well, on specific entities within our community which Vision Anchorage believes can play an important leadership role in implementing the Call to Action's strategic initiatives; and

WHEREAS, Vision Anchorage will, every four months, host all leadership entities who execute this Memorandum of Understanding at a plenary meeting where each may report on the progress to implement one or more of the strategic initiatives which fall within the scope and mission of the respective organization;

WHEREAS, in recognition of the MOA's support of the Call to Action, Vision Anchorage will, by July 15, 2003 adopt a list of suggested local legislative initiatives that the MOA can consider to advance economic development within the Municipality; and

WHEREAS Vision Anchorage will strive to foster a collaborative working relationship in the implementation of the Call to Action and the Anchorage 2020 Comprehensive Plan; now, therefore, the Municipality and the signatories hereto hereby agree as follows:

- 1. The parties agree to support the Call to Action as workable template to create and sustain economic vitality in Anchorage.
- 2. The Municipality, as part of its ongoing economic development efforts, will cochampion the Call to Action including, but not limited to, implementation of the workforce development initiative and readiness initiatives.
- 3. The Municipality will meet with Vision Anchorage over the next year on what steps, discussions and/or initiatives it has pursued to assist in implementing the Call to Action.
 - A. The Municipality will pay particular attention to activities pursued in support of the workforce development and readiness initiatives of the Call to Action.
- 4. After one (1) year, the Municipality will meet with Vision Anchorage to evaluate the success of its efforts and viability of the Call to Action plan and, further, what steps for the ensuing year, if any, should be pursued in furtherance of the Call of Action.
- 6. This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective as of April 1, 2003 and as to the other signatories when each signs this Memorandum.
