A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING
THE ALASKA SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY YOUTH SERVICE PROGRAM FOR ITS OUTSTANDING YOUTH
DEVELOPMENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN THE PAST FIVE YEARS

WHEREAS, the Alaska Spirit of Community Youth Service Program is celebrating five years of positive youth development by encouraging youth community service through leadership training and year round opportunities in all facets of community service; and

WHEREAS, the Program represents our community commitment to youth and acts as the local implementation of the National Prudential Youth Leadership Institute (PYLI) Program; and

WHEREAS, through the PYLI Program, over 400 Alaskan high school students from 39 different schools have been trained in creative leadership and to actively engage in service, school governance, and civic responsibility, addressing community problems such as hunger in children, school dropouts, homelessness, teen pregnancy, illiteracy, and the health of senior citizens; and

WHEREAS, graduates organize individual and group service projects to promoting reading, elderly well-being, and mentoring on each of the four annual National days of service and have assisted in Municipal elections and served as members of the Anchorage Youth Advisory Commission; and

WHEREAS, graduates serve younger children through Mountain View Boys & Girls Club, Clark Middle School, Big Brothers-Big Sisters, Kids Kitchen, and as returning program graduate assistants to train and encourage peers in subsequent PYLI programs; and


WHEREAS, the Alaska Spirit of Community Youth Service Program has been recognized as one of the top PYLI initiatives in the Nation and has been nominated for the William T. Grant Foundation Youth Development Prize recognizing high-quality, collaborative efforts that advance knowledge while increasing opportunities for young people to move successfully through adolescence.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that the

Alaska Spirit of Community Youth Service Program

is recognized and honored for its commitment to developing youth as leaders in service and citizenship in their communities.
