A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING MAY 9, 2003  
AS "POLICE MEMORIAL DAY," AND REMEMBERING AND HONORING THOSE WHO HAVE  
GIVEN THEIR LIVES IN THE LINE OF DUTY

WHEREAS, law enforcement duties require great sacrifices on the part of law enforcement  
officers and their families; and

WHEREAS, law enforcement officers serve the public every hour of every day of the year,  
and they often risk their lives to be the peacekeepers of our communities; and

WHEREAS, in Alaska, a total of 38 law enforcement officers have sacrificed their lives since  
Statehood, and Anchorage has lost seven of these officers; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2003, Alaska will observe it's 15<sup>th</sup> Annual Police Memorial Day which  
coincides with National Police Memorial Day - a National day of remembrance for law enforcement  
officers.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

**Section 1:** That the Assembly recognizes May 9, 2003, as "Police Memorial Day."

**Section 2:** That all residents are urged to pause and remember the many brave law  
enforcement officers who have made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty.
