A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY OPPOSING THE TRANSFER OF WORKFORCE INVESTMENT ACT PROGRAMS TO THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 requires state boards to develop an annual funding
formula for local workforce areas based on standards consistent with the Act and established in the state
plan; and

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998 further requires that Federal funding allocations
be disbursed to local workforce areas as designated by the Governor and set forth in the state plan for the
purpose of delivering Workforce Investment Act programs and services within each local area, and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage and the contiguous Matanuska-Susitna Borough form the Anchorage/Mat-Su Local Workforce Area which was certified as a local workforce area under Executive Order 182 on June 3, 1999 and re-certified by the Alaska Workforce Investment Board in 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Anchorage/Mat-Su Local Workforce Area is comprised of the geographical area that contains more than half of the State's population, businesses, jobs, and State legislators; and

WHEREAS, the Alaskan citizens residing in the Anchorage/Mat-Su Local Workforce Area can be better served by local administration of Workforce Investment Act programs and services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves

Section 1: That this body opposes the transfer of Workforce Investment Act Programs to the State of Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development.

Section 2: That the State of Alaska Department of Labor and Workforce Development is requested
to publicize and issue its formula and correspondent funding levels to the two local chief elected officials, local
Workforce Investment Boards, and their respective fiscal agents; and move swiftly to issue Workforce
Investment Act Program Grants to its two local Workforce Boards to assure time for appropriate planning and
uninterrupted service delivery within the local workforce investment areas.

<u>Section 4:</u> That copies of this resolution will be forwarded to the United States Department of Labor
Employment and Training Administration, the Governor, and the Alaska State Legislature immediately upon
passage and approval.
