A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY RECOGNIZING AND HONORING
RANDY SMITH FOR HIS LONG-STANDING COMMITMENT TO THE COMMUNITY OF MOUNTAIN
VIEW AND THE MUNICIPALITY OF ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, Randolph C. "Randy" Smith was born July 30, 1946, in Iola, Kansas, graduated from Alameda High School in 1964, served in the Air Force from 1966 - 1969, was a Vietnam Veteran and after leaving the Air Force, he came to Alaska as a professional photographer; and

WHEREAS, since arriving in Mountain View in the early 1980's, he owned EZ Money Loan and Pawn, was Executive Director of the Alaska Outdoor Council, was a legislative lobbyist, worked with the Alaska Professional Sport Fishing Association and Alaska Professional Hunters Association, was a firearms education and safety instructor, was the driving force behind community improvement in Mountain View, and served as Mountain View Community Council President many of the past 20 years; and

WHEREAS, he founded and headed the Mountain View Community Patrol and was responsible for the creation of Mountain View's Nationally recognized Clean Up Program, including hauling away junk cars, which resulted in Mountain View winning the 1989 Neighborhood of the Year Award from Neighborhoods USA; and

WHEREAS, Randy Smith was one of the first responders to the Mountain View Elementary School in 2001 when a slasher attacked the school children and he stood in the doorway of a classroom to protect a teacher and an injured child by distracting the attacker until police arrived on scene; and

WHEREAS, he helped rebuild the Mountain View Community Recreation Center, was the impetus behind a recent bill ensuring that residences used as methamphetamine labs are cleaned up before a new family moves in, and was working to make the Mountain View Arts and Cultural District a reality; and

WHEREAS, Randy Smith was a driving force and will be missed in his community and in the Municipality of Anchorage.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves that


