A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY ENCOURAGING AND
SUPPORTING THE USE OF CITY LAND TO HELP HOUSE DISABLED AND ELDERLY
VETERANS IN ANCHORAGE

WHEREAS, Alaska is one of only two states in the Nation without a veterans' home;
and

WHEREAS, more than 30,000 of those veterans are residents of the Municipality
of Anchorage; and

WHEREAS, although the final decisions and funding for construction of the home
will require a joint effort on the part of the State and Federal governments, the Municipality
of Anchorage can be a part of the solution; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Anchorage has suitable land available for this project
and has a responsibility to help those in need.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That this body encourages and supports the use of City land to help
house disabled and elderly veterans in Anchorage.

Section 2: That this resolution is effective upon passage and approval.
