A RESOLUTION OF THE ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING PASSAGE OF SENATE BILL NO. 133, "AN ACT RELATING TO A STATE VETERANS' HOME; DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A STATE **VETERANS' HOME: AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE"**

WHEREAS, Alaska's military and veterans have served us well by protecting and defending the freedom and human rights we cherish and by fighting the Worldwide war against terrorism; and

WHEREAS, in return, we now have the honor of caring for our veterans and defending their right to be treated with respect and dignity; and

WHEREAS, Alaska is one of only two states in the Nation without a home for veterans, even though, with 70,000 veterans, Alaska has more veterans per capita than any other state except Wyoming; and

WHEREAS, funding assistance up to two-thirds of the cost of construction and one-half of the cost of operation of a stand-alone State Veterans' Home may be available through the Federal Veterans Affairs Program; and

WHEREAS, Anchorage Mayor Begich has pledged to identify suitable land within the Anchorage Heritage Land Bank to be contributed to the development of a Veterans' Home; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 133 directs the Department of Administration to submit an application for Federal assistance to the Federal Secretary of Veterans Affairs for construction of a State Veterans' Home with a capacity of 150 beds or the maximum bed capacity that is eligible for Federal Assistance under 38 U.S.C. 8131 - 8136, whichever is less.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Anchorage Municipal Assembly resolves:

Section 1: That this body supports passage of Senate Bill No. 133 which directs the Department of Administration to apply for Federal grants available for construction of a State Veterans' Home by January 1, 2004, and provides for an effective date.

Section 2: That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Murkowski and the Alaska State Legislature upon passage and approval.
