1 The accompanying Assembly Resolution appropriates Three Hundred Twenty Three Thousand Dollars

2 (\$323,000) as a cash contribution from the Department of Health and Human Services 2003 operating budget

3 (101) and Two Hundred Seventy Thousand One Hundred Ninety Five Dollars (\$270,195) from the U.S.

Environmental Protection Agency to the Federal Categorical Grant Fund (241) for the Department of Health and
 Human Services. This appropriation will provide the funding necessary to continue air quality monitoring,

6 enforcement and planning activities from January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2003.

7 8 The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) operates an air quality program consistent with federal, state and local statutes and regulations. The agency maintains an ambient air monitoring system for carbon 9 monoxide and particulate matter. Staff enforces local code, issues air quality operating permits, responds to air 10 quality complaints and information requests from citizens, analyzes air quality data, and issues air quality reports 11 and advisories. Staff also performs air quality modeling analyses required by Federal Highway Administration 12 for AMATS transportation planning. Included in this year's EPA grant to DHHS is \$135,000 earmarked for an 13 14 indoor air quality monitoring study. 15
