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Subject: A RESOLUTION APPROPRIATING \$98,800 FROM AREAWIDE GENERAL FUND BALANCE TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ASSEMBLY TO COVER THE COST OF THE APRIL 1, 2003 ELECTION AND THE SUBSEQUENT RECOUNT

6 During the 2003 budget process, three service levels within the Department of Assembly's 7 Elections organization remained unfunded. Those service levels included \$100,000 for a runoff 8 election, \$18,500 for miscellaneous expenses, and an additional \$30,000 to provide training and 9 on-site support supplied by the Accuvote contractor. Fortunately, there was no need for a runoff, and the vendor provided the on-site support at no additional cost. After an audit of the 10 total costs incurred, the Municipal Clerk's Office has determined that due to other challenges 11 during the April 2003 election, additional funding was required to cover the costs of the election 12 13 and the recount. A summary of these costs follows: 14

Personnel

Precinct workers and the Election Commission were given a pay increase of \$2.00 per hour in an effort to match the State election workers' compensation. Due to the reapportionment, there were five additional precincts to staff, and there was an increase in the number of workers because of the new absentee voting sites and extended hours of operation. In addition, the Clerk's Office employee count was down by two persons between January and April resulting in the need to hire more election workers.

Other Costs

Facility rentals, moving expenses, and supplies normally budgeted at \$18,500, increased by \$19,812; advertising expenses increased by \$13,607; ballot costs due to larger ballots to accommodate added text increased by \$13,500; and additional security deemed necessary was sought at a cost of \$1,500.

Recount Expenses

Costs incurred for the requested recount totalled \$46,958¹

\$40,000 was appropriated by the Assembly at the meeting of April 15, 2003, and \$12,200 of this amount was reimbursed through the required recount deposit. The prior appropriation and the deposit contributed to reducing the funding gap to the requested \$98,800.

Legal Expenses

A legal challenge to Proposition 2 resulted in legal fees of \$29,980.

As a result of the additional election expenses as outlined above, and the unanticipated costs relating to a recount and legal challenge, it is now necessary to request that the Department of Assembly's budget be revised to cover the outstanding invoices related to expenses for the April 2003 election and recount. The funding information follows:
