September 23, 2003

In accordance with AO NO. 2000-106(S), this memorandum provides information required for submission and approval of the preliminary design for the Muldoon Middle School, Community Center and Library. The School Board approved the Conceptual Design on September 8, 2003.

The School Board approved the selection of Kumin Associates, Inc. as the Architects of Record on March 31, 2003, ASD Memorandum #225 (2002-2003) and the Municipal Assembly approved the selection on April 8, 2003 (AR #2003-57).

AO NO. 2000-106(S) requires a description of the proposed school site, school building and building program; the projected student population; the total construction budget and the funding source; the projected project schedule; and any known neighborhood impacts, comments, reactions, which reflect potential impacts of the school building on the neighboring community. These responses follow:

Acquired in 2003, the 30.5 acre site is located on DeBarr Road just west of Muldoon Road on a parcel anticipated to be incorporated into the proposed Creekside Town Center. The site is relatively flat and occupies a portion of a former mobile home park.

The scope of this project is to provide a conceptual design for a Middle School, Community Center and Library. Pending approval by the School Board and Assembly, the funded design for the Middle School will be further developed. A construction budget is being determined based on the proposed design. The Muldoon Middle School will accommodate 1,058 students in grades 6 through 8.

A series of public meetings began in June 2003. The Design Team, working with the Building Design Committee, initially developed five concept options. The best features of these were combined to form a sixth and final concept. (Attachment A) During this public meeting process, there were no negative neighborhood impacts identified.

The planning process involved adherence to the requirements of the Districtwide Middle School Educational Specifications approved by the School Board October 9, 2000, ASD

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AR 2003-264 A Resolution of the Anchorage Municipal Assembly Approving the Subject:

Preliminary (Conceptual) Design for the Muldoon Middle School, Community

Center and Library

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On September 23, 2002, the Assembly voted to delay considering AR No. 2003-264 until the next regular meeting, set for October 7, 2003. Assembly members expressed concerns over the compatibility of the conceptual design of the proposed Muldoon Middle School, Community Center and Library with the Creekside Town Center master plan. Following this meeting, staffs of the Municipality of Anchorage and the Anchorage School District met to discuss the issues raised by the Assembly and jointly reached the following conclusions:

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- The concepts presented by the Anchorage School District (ASD), while previously agreed to by the Municipal administration, were not in concert with the thinking of the new Administration.
- The Community Center and Library are too large as proposed, and need to be reduced in scope. 2.
- The Community Center and Library should be combined in one structure. 3.
- It is not appropriate or desirable to combine the middle school with the Community Center and 4. Library in one structure.
- The Library/Community Center should be sited to maximize public accessibility. 5.
- The architect for the Muldoon Middle School, Community Center and Library should meet with the architect for the Muldoon Town Center to assure that the designs of these projects maximize opportunities for mutual benefit to each of the projects.

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These issues were discussed at the joint Assembly-School Board meeting held on October 3, 2003. This body concluded that while they recommend the Concept Design Report be approved by the Assembly on October 7th, remaining inconsistencies between the concept design and the Creekside Town Center plan should be resolved quickly. Consequently, ASD has scheduled a meeting at the Northeast Community Council's office at 5:30 p.m. on Thursday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, and urges that all interested parties be present to resolve outstanding issues. In addition, Kumin Associates will proceed to modify the size and scale of the library and community center into one common structure.

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The Administration recommends Assembly approval of the current concept design of the Muldoon Middle School, Community Center and Library at its next meeting. This will allow planning to proceed to the schematic phase. During this next phase, the issues identified above will be addressed and resolved. The Assembly will have an opportunity to review the updated plan when ASD brings the Schematic Design Report forward for Assembly approval.
