WHEREAS, in 1997, the Housing and Neighborhood Development (HAND) Commission was
formed to perform the combined functions of the Housing Advisory Commission and the Community
Development Block Grant Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the HAND Commission is to advise the Mayor and the Assembly on
issues related to community development needs and strategies to effect revitalization of lower-income and
at-risk neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Commission consists of 15 members representing the real estate industry, banking
industry, not-for-profit housing organizations, homebuilders, residential shelter providers, lower-income and
at-risk neighborhoods, and citizens who experience disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the HAND Commission has worked diligently through the process of determining
funding priorities for the Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan, Annual Action Plan,
and Citizen Participation Plan; and


WHEREAS, several of the current and retiring members have served our community as HAND
